The Kirby Center for Constitutional Studies in Citizenship, located in Washington, D.C., sponsors an annual Constitution Day Celebration that commemorates the signing of the Constitution and the first principles that underpin and give life to the American experiment in self-government. The Center also hosts the monthly Kirby Center Lecture Series, formerly known as “First Principles on First Fridays.” The lectures address significant and timely political, historical, and economic topics from a constitutional perspective.
